We had a raffle in which each vendor donated one item and we raised \$193 and donated the money to Mike Chapman, a life long Herald resident to help with medical bills for a recent incident. Genealogy room was open to the public for viewing. Danny Williams and Rose Newcomb were there to share history about the community. Union Ridge Church donated a picture to be displayed in the Genealogy room of the center. Danny Williams accepted the picture on behalf of the township. Levies were passed. White County Multi-Jurisdictional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan resolution was passed. New Business: Certification of 3/5 Majority vote forum required for the 2024 Annual Financial Statement. Tony made a motion to accept the vote. David 2<sup>nd</sup> it. Motion carried. No Road Commissioner's report. No other Business. David made a motion to adjourn.
